

Tournament Withdraw and Refund Policy

In the event of a tournament withdraw; the player must notify the West Virginia Golf Association Office at 304-391-5000 no later than the entry deadline. If withdraw is made prior to tournament deadline, the player may receive a refund regardless of reason. For a withdraw made after the entry deadline, the player may receive a refund only if player has experienced a sudden illness or injury, and only if the West Virginia Golf Association is notified prior to the first round of the tournament.

To Receive a Refund: ALL refund requests must be submitted in writing to Brad Ullman (bullman@wvga.org), Chris Slack (cslack@wvga.org), Cory Hoshor, (choshor@wvga.org). For all WVGA Championships, a **\$20** administrative fee will be assessed. For all one-day tournaments (Callaway Junior Tour, WV Senior Series, Wendy's Amateur Tour) refunds, a administrative fee of **\$8** will be assessed. All refunds will be issued in check form. Refund checks are mailed once a week on Fridays from the WVGA office.

Transfer of Entry: For West Virginia Golf Association One-Day events only, players may transfer their entry fee to another one-day event site. To successfully transfer the entry fee, players must submit a written request to Cory Hoshor or Chris Slack. For West Virginia Golf Association Championships, players will not be able to transfer any of their registration entry fees. If a player is unable to compete in a registered event, they must then follow the WVGA refund policy to receive a refund of their entry fee.
