

# Callaway Junior Tour

## Code of Conduct

### Player Conduct:

Every player is expected to follow the guidelines set forth in this Callaway Junior Tour Code of Conduct.

- Players are expected to treat fellow players, Tour staff, golf course staff with respect at all times
- Players will not be allowed to throw clubs or any equipment at any time
- Players will not be allowed to curse or yell at any time
- Players are expected to be courteous and congratulate fellow players on the course
- Players should never be on their cell phones, unless its an emergency situation
- Dress Code:
  - Players must always wear a golf shirt and it must be tucked in while at the course, including during registration and awards
  - Players must never wear their hats backwards while at the event
  - Players may wear shorts or pants, but never denim of any kind at any event

**NOTE: 1<sup>st</sup> Offense Could Result in Possible Disqualification**

**NOTE: All the above applies during Registration, Trophy Presentations and Practice Rounds**

### Spectator Conduct:

Parents are encouraged to come and support their children on the Callaway Junior Tour at every event but there are rules that must be followed as well

- Spectator Carts:
  - Spectator Carts are available at every event, however almost every event will sell out of carts, so if you do not get a cart that day do not take it out on the folks allowing us to use their golf course.
  - If you have an issue of any kind please let the WVGA staff member know. Courses only have so many carts at their facility so please know they will sell out almost every single event
  - Carts **MUST** remain on paths at all times. If no path is available, please stay in the rough.
- Caddying/coaching/talking:
  - We do not allow parents to caddy or coach their kids at any time.
  - We expect talking to be limited to cheering on the kids, asking if they need a snack/drink, and showing players where their golf balls are.
  - Do not at any time be around the players chatting, or walking up the fairways or pushing/carrying their golf bags.

**NOTE: Parents breaking any of the above could subject the Player to penalty, including Disqualification**
